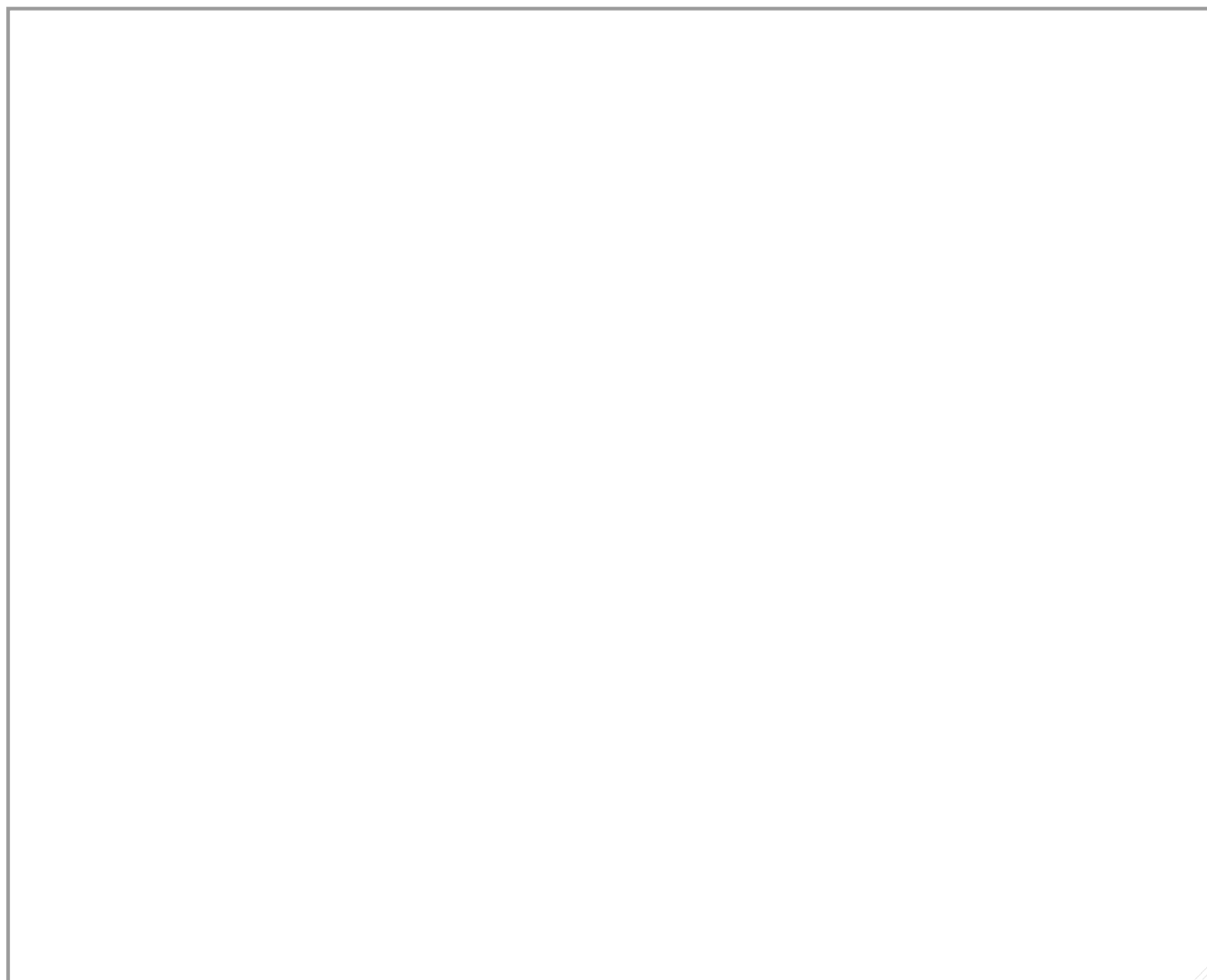


Abstract

- A statement of what will be done with the results of this project
- A statement of the significance of this project to your discipline and society
